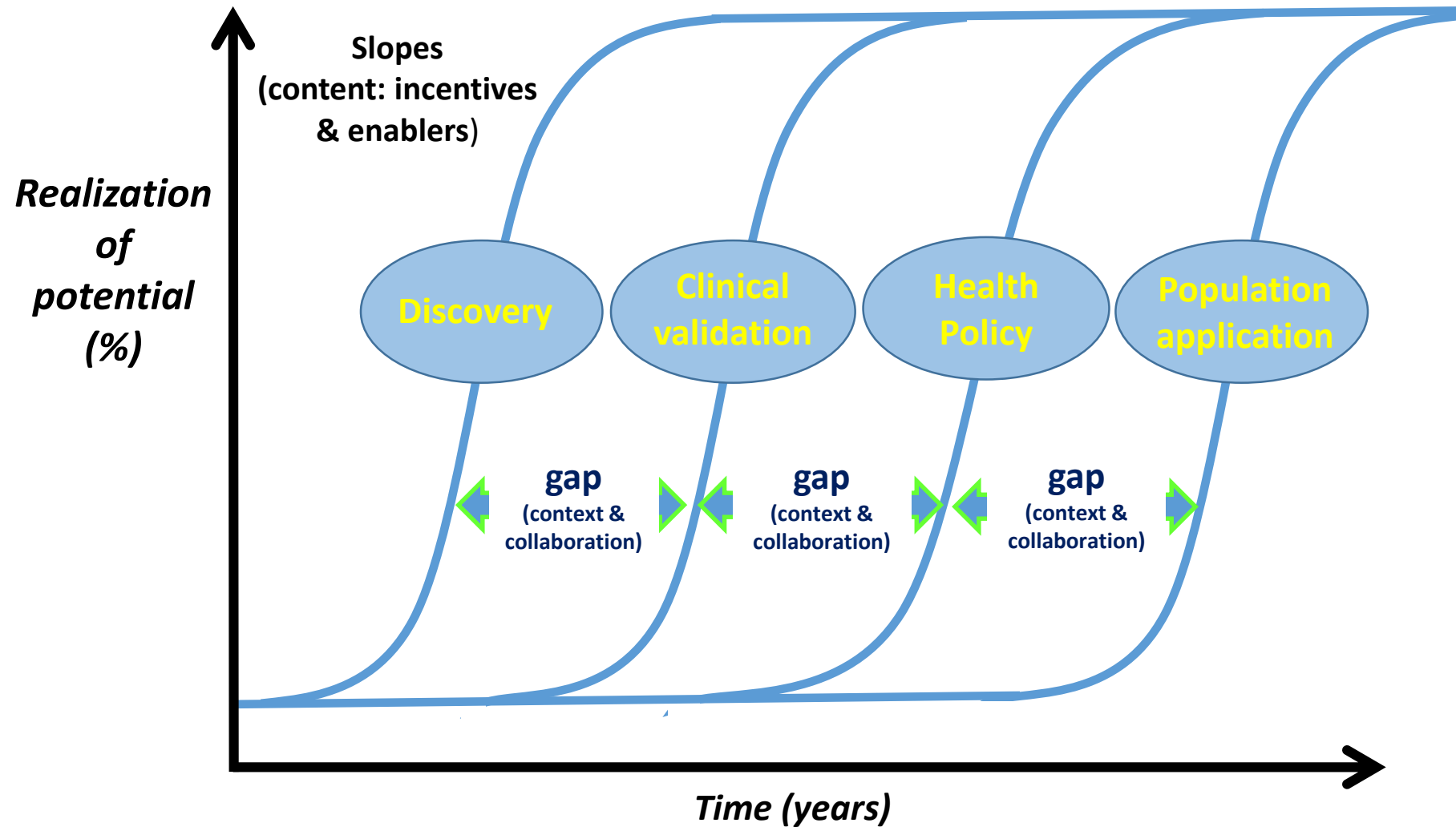

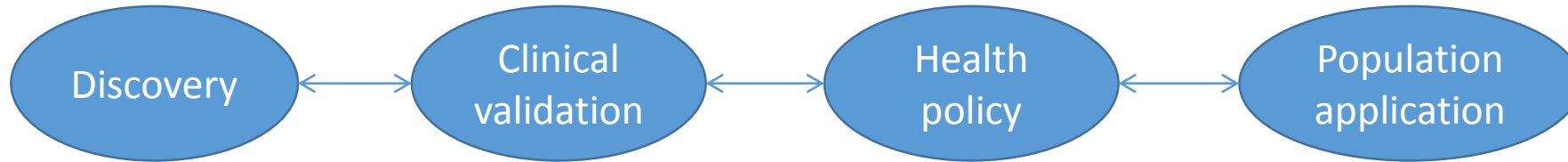

# What conditions underlie effective access to innovation?

## **Culture**

- principles: trust; mutual respect; shared accountability
- “true” collaboration
- relationships: inclusivity; dependability; integrity
- internal & external alignment/collaboration

**Content:** aligned with context: B.C. reality

**Collaboration:** common & shared purpose.

# What conditions underlie effective access to innovation ?

## Preparedness & readiness:

- government commitment & resolve
- societal expectation & mobilization
- health agenda prioritization
- leadership of all stakeholders : transformative people
- economic growth: resource allocation/re-allocation
